Certification Fee Schedule

Detailed Breakdown of Fees

The Alaska Fire Standards Council has the following fee schedule in place for testing and certification.

\$15 Written Test- *Single fee for tests taken during the same sitting (e.g. FFI & HMO)*

\$15 Practical Test- *Single fee for combined practical examinations (e.g. FFI & HMO)*

\$15 Certificate Administration Fee- *per certificate issued (Effective Date – July 1, 2011)*

Example - A firefighter testing for Firefighter I with Haz-Mat Aware/Ops will pay \$15 for the FF I and Haz-Mat Aware/Ops written test + \$15 for the FF I and Haz-Mat Aware/Ops practical test + \$15 for FF I Certificate+ \$15 for Haz-Mat Aware/Ops Certificate = \$60 Fee

\$15 Reciprocity – per certificate

Example - A firefighter requesting reciprocity for Firefighter I and Hazardous Materials Awareness/Operations will pay \$15 for FF I + \$15 for HMO = \$30 Fee

- Applications for certification will not be processed until the appropriate fee is received.
- Please make checks or money orders payable to the *Alaska Fire Standards Council*.
- AFSC fees assist with administrative costs associated with the testing and certification process and all fees are **non-refundable**.

Summary of Final Exam and Processing Fees by Certification Type

Common certification levels/requests:

Firefighter I with Hazardous Materials Awareness/Operations with certificates (written/practical/seals)	\$60
Firefighter I or Firefighter II (no Haz Mat) with certificate (written/practical/seal)	\$45
Firefighter I ONLY with certificate (written/practical/seal)	\$45
Hazardous Materials Awareness/Operations ONLY with certificate (written/practical/seal)	\$45
Fire Instructor I with certificate (written/practical/seal)	\$45
Written Retest ONLY(any type)	\$15
Aircraft Rescue Firefighter with certificate (written/practical/seal)	\$45
Rapid Intervention Technician with certificate (written/practical)	\$45
Fire Officer (written/practical/seal)	\$45
Reprint of previously issued Alaska certificate (new cert with seal- per level)	\$15
Request for certificate copy (per certificate copy with a maximum charge of \$20 per individual file, per each request)	\$10

For Accredited programs the above fees will include all related seals

The following applications generally do not require the administration of an AFSC exam and no fee is charged:

- Fire Service Instructor re-certification **if** the candidate does not require a written test
- Specialty Instructor (i.e. EVD, Marine, RIT, etc.) **Must** have a current FSI.
- Certified Fire Investigator re-certification **if** the candidate does not require a written test
