****A valid CPR credential includes any one of the following: a CPR card; completed course rosters; or a letter from a certified CPR Instructor attesting to the applicant's successful completion of a CPR program. The card or letter must clearly indicate that the course included adult, child, and infant CPR and airway obstruction relief maneuvers, including two-rescuer CPR and barrier devices.*

*****Basic fire safety education is an Alaska specific requirement for Firefighter I certification (skill requirement is referred to NFPA 1001, Section 6.5.2)*
