### Colonel Hall to Lead Alaska Wildlife Troopers

(ANCHORAGE, Alaska) – Commissioner Monegan is pleased to announce the appointment of a new Director of the Alaska Wildlife Troopers. Effective July 1, 2017, Colonel Steve Hall took over the official duties of leading the Division.

Col. Steve Hall began his law enforcement career with the Department of Public Safety, as a member of Recruit Class #42 in 1993. Following his academy graduation and field training, he was posted in Kodiak with the Division of Fish & Wildlife Protection (F&WP). In 1998 he transferred from the F&WP to the Division of Alaska State Troopers as a patrol trooper in Kodiak. His rise through the ranks included Corporal at the Public Safety Academy in Sitka and as commander of "A" Detachment in Juneau. Colonel Hall promoted to Captain in November 2013 and transferred to Anchorage where he was the Southern Detachment Commander for the Alaska Wildlife Troopers (previously known as F&WP). In addition to these assignments, Colonel Hall has been a firearms instructor with the Department for more than 20 years. He also represented the Division of Alaska Wildlife Troopers with the Board of Fisheries and managed the Division's Vessel Section.
