## Rural Fire Protection Specialist

#### Course Description:

This 94-hour course is required for all individuals serving as a Village Public Safety Officer. It involves everything from setting up a small rural fire department, training, providing fire prevention programs and managing the fire department within the village.

This course meets the requirements to become a State of Alaska Rural Fire Protection Specialist through the Alaska Fire Standards Council. All fees for testing and certification are included in the cost of the course.

#### Student Responsibilities:

Course materials are provided to registered students at the beginning of class 100% attendance and participation is required. The student or their sponsoring agency is responsible for all transportation costs, food and lodging.

#### Prerequisite:

Closed for Village Public Safety Officers only.
